- D) Identify an example of ideas being linked across paragraphs by adverbials of time [for example, later], place [for example, nearby] and number [for example, secondly] or tense choices [for example, he had seen her before].
- E) Identify an auxiliary/modal verb.
- F) Identify a relative pronoun.
- G) Identify a relative clause.
- H) Identify an example of brackets, dashes or commas to indicate parenthesis.
- I) Identify where a comma has been used to avoid ambiguity.
- J) Identify devices to build cohesion within a paragraph [for example, then, after that, this, firstly].
