Communication, Language and Literacy

- Phase 3 in phonics sessions looking at digraphs and trigraphs. These sheets will now be stuck in their literacy books. You will see these at parents evening.
- Reading stories linked to our theme.
- Reading non-fiction texts about superheroes and real life.
- Start learning the routines of guided reading sessions.
- Introduction to the new library.
- Start to learn to write in sentences including the use of capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.
- The children will continue to bring home reading books and words.

These lessons will incorporate our PHSE work, be used to discuss new ideas to help improve the school and find solutions to problems that arise during the school year. The children will continue to take part in circle time an opportunity for all children to participate and listen to one another.
